Agreement to the "Latvia-Lithuania programme 2014-2020" and commitment to provide co-financing

Having regard to the EU regulations laying down provisions on the European Union's Structural and Investment Funds, in particular Regulations (EU) No 1303/2013, No 1301/2013 and No 1299/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council, with specific reference to article 8(9) of the Regulation No 1299/2013,

the Republic of Latvia, presented by the Ministry of the Environmental Protection and Regional Development, hereby

- 1) confirms its agreement to the content of the "Latvia-Lithuania cross border cooperation programme 2014-2020" as approved by the Joint Programming Committee of the Programme on June 16, 2014;
