...brings together local and regional authorities voluntarily committed to implementing EU climate and energy objectives on their territory.


The Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy



- A unique bottom-up movement shaped by cities, for cities
- A shared vision of decarbonised and resilient cities where citizens have access to secure, sustainable and affordable energy
- A growing and inclusive community now counting over 7,600 signatories representing over 210 million citizens

Commitments



Signatories pledge to:

- Reduce CO₂ (and possibly other GHG) emissions by at least 40% by 2030
- Increase resilience by adapting to the impacts of climate change
- Develop measures to increase access to sustainable and affordable energy
- Translate their political commitment into local results by developing local action plans and reporting on their implementation

The Covenant step by step







A reference framework for action

- Consistency and transparency thanks to a common reporting framework for all, flexible and adjustable to local realities
- High visibility via personalised signatory profiles on the Covenant website
- **Evaluation** of the data reported by the Commission's independent scientific centre (signatories are suspended in case of non-compliance)




